Regular meeting was called to order at 7:05 p.m. by President Roteliuk. Board members present were Scott Larson, Oliver Tafelmeyer, and Tammie Mahoney. Also present Charles Soper, Sup't, Karen Gullicks, Elem. Principal, Patti Syverson, Business Manager, Wendy Peterson, SEA/teacher, Sheila Kolschefski, Emily Hoops, teachers, and Chris Peltier, parent.

Agenda was reviewed.

M/S/C: Larson/Mahoney to approve the minutes for the January 14th Regular Meeting.

M/S/C: Mahoney/Larson to approve the January board bills in the amount of \$26,769.51, payroll in the amount of \$175,888.56 with transfers in the amount of \$100,000.00.

SUPERINTENDENT/H.S. PRINCIPAL: Enrollment is currently at 116 including 4 preschool students. NAEP testing took place with students in grades 4 and 8. State Longitudinal Data System (SLDS) was discussed. Smarter Balance tests will be administered starting in March.

New programs sponsored by the Parent Boosters are the Golden Ticket program for grades 7 through 12 and the Fabulous Flash program for Elementary students.

FACILITIES: Some minor boiler repairs and one plumbing repair were discussed. Coal bin repair was also discussed.

LEGISLATION: Different topics were reviewed that are currently being discussed in this year's legislature.

2015-2016 SCHOOL CALENDAR: Discussed and will be re-visited at the March meeting.

M/S/C: Tafelmeyer/Mahoney to approve the speech and language contract for 2015-2016.

ELEMENTARY PRINCIPAL: Miss Ortloff and Mrs. Gullicks will be attending a workshop on administrating the Smarter Balance test. Students and teachers participated in the 100th day of school on January 29th. We had great coverage in the Minot Daily News.

Discussion of sports practices, school bus use for outside functions, Summer School Pass Through, and school spirit during games were all discussed.

Superintendent evaluation is due on March 15th. Paperwork is due back to Cody Roteliuk by Feb. 21st.
